- Guard the excellence of scientific research at all EAAE events.
- Pave the way for the new venues for the agricultural research.
- Increase recognisability of EAAE events in other continents: Africa, Americas, Asia, Australia and Oceania.

What I would like to see achieved in the next Board period (September 2017 – August 2020):

- Increase of EAAE membership, especially in the underrepresented regions: eg. Central and Eastern Europe.
- Organization of more types EAAE events, apart from currently existing.
- Higher involvement of young researchers in decision making.
- More initiatives addressed to young researchers.
- Maintain support for young researchers especially from New Member and Candidate Countries for example via awards, travel grants, help in organizing EAAE Seminars and Congresses, help in publishing strategies, etc.
